Purpose

The purpose of the Redwood Scholarship Fund is to provide financial assistance to qualifying seniors who are continuing their education after graduation from Redwood High School.

Awards

These scholarships are granted on the basis of financial need without regard to race, color, creed or gender. Scholarships currently range from around \$500 to \$5,000. The actual amount of any scholarship award will not be made public; only the names of the winners will be announced. In addition to the general scholarships, the Foundation grants several special awards including: (1) the Nicole Adams Memorial Scholarship, available to any student who participates in a sport at any level, (2) the Sandra Egger Memorial Scholarship, available to students who excel in the visual arts, and (3) the Chelini Award, available to students selected by the Counseling Department who have overcome significant obstacles and demonstrated character and leadership.

- Financial need
- Good citizenship
- Perseverance and determination
- Good moral character
- Academic achievement
- Criteria specific to the endowed awards

Applications must be completed by each student applicant personally. The decision of the committee is final. Please be assured that the Redwood Scholarship Committee members who will be reviewing the scholarship application have all signed a confidentiality agreement. Any information you submit will be treated as confidential; however, if you are a scholarship recipient, we reserve the right to release your name and the name of your university/college to the media.

Deadline

The completed application must be submitted to the **Counseling Office**, **Room 103**, **no later than 3:30 p.m. Monday**, **April 19**, **2010**. LATE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

 ESSAY OPTION 2 Why are you deserving of this scholarship? Include a paragraph describing your best attributes that post-high-school education will further develop.
Checklist for Teacher Reference (page 6) in a sealed envelope with your name written on the back and the words "Teacher's Checklist" on the front.
Letter of Recommendation from Reference 2 (page 7) in sealed envelope with your name written on the back and the word "Recommendation" on the front.
